

Cops: Rhode Island man nabbed on Hutch with pills in trunk

SCARSDALE — A Rhode Island man was arrested on a felony drug charge after Westchester County Police reported finding 373 Oxycodone pills hidden in a shopping bag in his car's trunk.

Yeudy Reyes Perez, 28, was pulled over on the northbound Hutchinson River Parkway at Weaver Street in Scarsdale after Officer Joaquim Brito observed him driving on the road's shoulder at 10:25 p.m. Tuesday, county police spokesman Kieran O'Leary said.

Perez admitted that he had driven to the Bronx to purchase Oxycodone that he could resell in Rhode Island, O'Leary said. The painkillers sell on the black market for as much as \$10 each.

He was charged with third-degree criminal possession of a controlled substance and given summonses for traffic violations. He is being held at the Westchester County jail in Valhalla, pending a court appearance.
