

Police will ramp up DWI patrols on Super Bowl Sunday

Police throughout the Lower Hudson Valley will be out in force Sunday night looking for people who may celebrate a little too much at Super Bowl parties.

State police will have extra troopers working the roads Sunday night, including roving DWI patrols, Major Michael Kopy said today.

“We’re going to have a number of details throughout the Lower Hudson Valley, including saturation patrols in certain areas,” Kopy said. “We’ll be moving people from non-patrol positions to patrols during certain points over the weekend, including Sunday night.”

Kopy said police expect a higher than average amount of people driving under the influence on Super Bowl Sunday and are adjusting their patrols to address it.

Westchester County police also plan extra patrols, spokesman Kieran O’Leary said.

But like state police, Westchester police don’t want to say exactly where those extra patrols will be working.

“Whether you are celebrating on Sunday night or drowning your sorrows, make sure to take a cab or have a designated driver if

you have been drinking. Our officers are always vigilant in enforcing DWI laws and Super Bowl Sunday will be no exception,” O’Leary said.

Local police in Putnam and Westchester counties are also planning to increase patrols Sunday night after the Super Bowl battle between the New York Giants and the New England Patriots.
